

March 28<sup>th</sup> 1854

The Governor this day issued a Requisition upon the Governor of Delaware for the apprehension of and delivery to Robert M. Hainsley, of one William Thomas late of Cecil County in this State charged on the oath of William Thomas with Larceny.

The Governor issued today a Requisition upon the Hon. William Branch, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of Columbia, for the apprehension and delivery of John Jackson of a certain Richard Bassett a fugitive from justice charged by indictment in the Criminal Court for Baltimore City with Forgery.

March 29<sup>th</sup>

The Governor directed publication of Notice of the application having been made for the Pardon of Samuel Howard, Negro, convicted of Larceny at the April Term 1851 of the Circuit Court for Washington County and sentenced to be confined in the Penitentiary till May 9. 1854.

April 10<sup>th</sup>

The Governor this day directed publication of the usual Notice in the matter of the application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus in the case of John or Lorenzo D. Larrison under two indictments, for Forgery, in the Circuit Court for Talbot County.

The Governor this day granted a Pardon to William N. Kercheval convicted on indictment at November Term 1853 of the Circuit Court for Talbot County of having shot one John Lockerman and sentenced to undergo confinement in the Penitentiary for eighteen months.
