The Governor also offered a reward of \$300 for the arrest and conviction of the murderer or murderers of one William Hobbs who was way-laid and shot in Saint Mary's County on the night of Sunday the 1st of Oct. 1854.

The Governor this day, upon the requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued to the Sheriff of Allegany County his warrant for the arrest of Brooks Pierce, a fugitive from justice, and his return to John C. Eschiff Esq. the Agent of the said State in that behalf.

Oct. 31st 1854.

The Governor this day pardoned Thomas Graves who was convicted, of Murder in the second degree, at January Term 1857 of the late Baltimore City Court, and sentenced to serve and labor in the Penitentiary for the period of nine years and five months.

Nov. 2^d 1854

The Governor this day granted a Writ Pro. in the matter of the State vs John Keeney indicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore City at its May Term 1854, upon a charge of Larceny and directed its transmission to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, to which Court the case had been removed.

November 4th

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Edward B. Buchanan and Abel Hussey Esqs Commissioners on the part of the State of Maryland to the exhibition of the works of Industry of all Nations to be held at Paris, France in the year 1855.
