

Dec. 8th 1854.

The Governor this day assigned L. Mason Campbell Esq. Counsel on the part of the State in the matter of the Appeal of the Slope Island pending in the Supreme Court of the United States.

The Governor this day issued his Proclamation offering a Reward of \$300. for the arrest and delivery to the Sheriff of Montgomery County of one Thomas M. Offutt recently convicted in the Circuit Court for the County aforesaid of shooting at Peter & Blaggett with intent to kill.

Dec. 11th 1854.

The Governor this day remitted a fine of \$200., imposed upon one Elijah Leates, on the 6th day of October 1854, by the Circuit Court for Somerset County for a violation of the Laws of Maryland against Gambling to the extent of the States interest in the same.

Dec. 12th 1854.

The Governor this day directed publication, in the Baltimore Daily Sun and Republican and Inquirer, of Notice of Application having been made for the pardon of Joseph Johnson, who was convicted of Larceny at the May Term 1854 of the Criminal Court of Baltimore and sentenced to serve and labor in the Penitentiary until the 28th day of June 1856.

The Governor this day assigned Bradley T. Johnson, States Attorney for Frederick County, as Counsel on the part of the State in State vs. Flannigan and State vs. Phelps, two causes now pending in the Court of Appeals on writs of Error from the Circuit Court for the County aforesaid.
