The Governor directed publication of Notice of application having been made for an unconditional *Nolle Prosequi* in the case of Andrew Conroy charged by indictment of the Grand Jury of Frederick County at the February Term 1852. of the Circuit Court for that County, with arson.

Feb. 2th

The Governor this day upon the Requisition of the Governor of the State of Virginia, issued his Warrant directed to the Sheriff of Allegany commanding him to arrest one Benjamin S. Cook, a Fugitive from Justice from that State, charged with having feloniously stolen, taken and carried away a Bay horse the property of one Isaac Hillis, and deliver him to Asa G. Leach the Agent of the State of the Virginia in that behalf.

Feb. 3th

The Governor granted a *Nolle Prosequi* in the case of Negro Boy Robert, slave of Doctor Arthur Poe of Howard County, under commitment for breaking into the store of John Jamest, upon condition that he be sold out of the State.

Also another in the case of Negro Boy "Dick" slave of Mrs. Amey Fox of same County charged as above, upon same condition.
