

April 26th

The Governor this day remitted the fines following which were imposed upon John Semmes by the Circuit Court for Prince George County viz. one of \$25 at Nov. Term 1854 for suffering large collections of Negroes to be shut in houses at night, and three of \$50 each for selling pint of liquor each to three several Negroes. These fines were remitted upon the recommendation of the Hon. Judge Evans and a large number of respectable Citizens of Prince George County.

28th

The Governor this day remitted a fine of two hundred dollars imposed upon William N. Davis by the Criminal Court of Baltimore at May Term 1854 for Inspecting Ground Black Oak Park without License, to the extent of the States interest in the same.

May 3rd

The Governor this day issued his requisition upon his Excellency the Governor of Virginia for the apprehension and delivery to William Logan, agent of this State in that behalf, of one Frank May, a fugitive from Justice who stands charged, upon the oath of Michael M. Garry, with the crime of Burglary in Washington County on the 21st day of April 1855. and said to be now in the Jail of Berkeley County, Virginia.

May 4th

The Governor approved the Bond of Lloyd N. Herring Acting Public at Middletown Frederick County.
