The Governor directed publication of the usual notice of Application having been made for a conditional pardon in the case of Edward Harney of Baltimore, City convicted by the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County April Term 1855 of Maryland. Baltimore, with obtaining goods from said Lewis & Co. under false pretences and also with conspiracy to defraud the said Lewis & Co. on about 1st Sept. 1854.
