The Governor, upon the Requisition of the Gov.
of the state of New York, issued his Warrant,
directed to any Sheriff, for the arrest and of James
McHenry, a fugitive from Justice charged by indictment
with the crime of larceny and supposed to have taken
refuge in Baltimore City. The said McHenry if
taken to be delivered to George W. Fuller the Agent of the
State of New York to receive him.

16th

The Governor, upon the requisition of the Governor of
the state of Pennsylvania, issued his Warrant,
to the Sheriff of Carroll County, for the delivery to Henry
Thomas, the Agent of the State of Pennsylvania in
that behalf, of a certain William Jones and
Aimee, charged upon the oath of Ed-
mond F. Shock with breaking into and Robbing
the store of Norbeck and Shock in said State, and
now confined in the jail of Carroll County.
