Jan. 30<sup>th</sup>

The Governor on this day transmitted to the House of Delegates copies of all the papers in the matter of the Writ Habeas granted to William Keenan, together with the reasons which influenced him in granting the same, in compliance with the Order of the House of the 22<sup>nd</sup> inst.

Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>

The Governor nominated to the Senate certain persons for Justices of the Peace in Prince Georges County. See Civil list.

The Governor issued a Requisition upon the Governor of Pennsylvania for the arrest and delivery to John Everett, Sheriff of Allegany County and Agent of this State in that behalf, of a certain Cyrus L. Snyder a fugitive from the Justice of this State said to have taken refuge in the State of Pennsylvania, and who is charged on the oath of Jonathan N. Seymour with having, by means of false and fraudulent pretences, obtained from the said Jonathan N. Seymour, one hundred Books of the value of twelve cents each, of the goods, chattels and property of the said Jonathan with intent to cheat & defraud him the said Jonathan.
