March 18th

The Governor issued civil commissions to officers in Prince Georges County, St Marys and Somerset counties, also to Talbot County except No 1, to Washington County except No 1 and 2, to Worcester County except No 1, also to the Board of Visitors of Frederick Female Seminary, also to W^m J. Murdoch Notary

Same day the Governor approved the Bond of W^m J. Murdoch Notary Public in place of Lewis Sutton of Balt City removed, and directed his commission to issue.

Same day the Governor appointed Thomas R Rich Notary Public in Baltimore City for the unexpired term of James L Parr resigned.

Same day the Governor approved the Bond of Theodore H. Knight Notary Public of Cecil County and directed his commission to issue.

Same day the Governor granted a Nolle Prosequi to Edward Mansfield indicted at the April term 1861 of Circuit Court for Kent County for aiding and abetting slaves to flee and burn a printing office, upon the express condition that he should forthwith leave the State and never return again.

March 19th

The Governor approved the Bond of Thomas R Rich Notary Public for the unexpired term of James L Parr resigned and directed his commission to issue. Same day commission issued.

Same day the Governor issued sundry military Commissions to Officers of the 1st Regiment of Maryland Volunteers. see Record of Military appointments

Same day the Governor issued Commission to Theodore H Knight Notary Public of Cecil County

March 20th

The Governor approved the Bonds of William Campbell Inspector General of Flour and James L Dorsey Assistant Inspector of Flour, also of John W. Hines Notary Public at Chestertown Kent County, same day Commission to John W Hines issued.
