The Governor issued a requisition directed to the Governor of Ohio for Daniel Heller and Joseph Shriver indicted for Larceny in the Circuit Court for Cecil County and requesting the delivery of said parties to Edw. Engrove Sheriff of Cecil County.

The Governor this day issued commissions to Henry H. Goldsborough of Talbot County as Comptroller of the Treasury, to William L. M. Straughen of Dorchester County as Commissioner of Public works for the fourth district they having been severally elected on the 4th instant.

Whereas an election was held in this State on the fourth of November instant for five members of Congress to represent the State in the Congress of the United States and for two Commissioners of Public works and the Constitution and Laws of the State make it the duty of the Governor in case of such elections to ascertain the number of votes given for each person voted for from the returns of the Judges of elections certified to him for that purpose and also provide that in all elections the person having the greatest number of votes shall be declared to be elected.
