any corporal punishment therefor, but that he shall stand and be in
the same plight and condition to all intents and purposes whatsoever
as if the said Felony whereof he the said Negro Peter hath been convicted
had never been done or committed. Witness our Trusty and well beloved
Robert Eden Esq. Lieutenant General and Chief Governor in and
over our said province this 30th day of March in the Fifth year of our
Dominion Anno Domini 1776.
