Gentlemen

In order to comply as far as it is in our
power with the Resolution passed at the last
Session respecting the situation of the several
Armouries of the State we have the honour
to send you a Statement, which contains all
the information that can at this time be given
with certainty on the subject. With regard to
the arms remaining dispersed through the
State we have given directions on both Shores
to have them collected and sent to the armouries
or placed out on sufficient security.

We avail ourselves of this occasion to
inform you that on the ninth of May last
we received a Certificate of the consent of the
Stockholders of the Bank of Columbia to the
acceptance of an act of the General Assembly
of Maryland entitled a Supplement to the
act entitled an act to establish a Bank in
the District of Columbia, which Certificate
was dated the third day of May last and
transmitted to us under the Corporate Seal
of the President Directors and Company of the
Bank of Columbia. and that the said Certifi-
cate is lodged among the Proceedings of the
Council agreeably to the directions of the
said act
