

day of June last gave directions in writing to the Treasurer to advance the sum of twenty thousand Dollars to the agent to be applied in the purchase of six per cent Stock for the use of the State - and on the day of July last on considering the situation of the finances and communicating with the Treasurer, we thought proper that the further sum of twenty thousand Dollars should be advanced and accordingly gave directions in writing to the Treasurer to advance that sum to the agent in pursuance of the latter part of the Resolution above stated.

We beg leave to state that under the Resolution directing a loan to Messieurs Hollingsworth, Rogers and Kent for rebuilding and completing the academy in Baltimore, these gentlemen have not produced to us any title to or mortgage of the said property - But that a proposition somewhat different was made to us on the subject, which we had no power to accede to.

In regard to the Bank Stock in England due to this State which is considered as being by former acts and Resolutions still under the superintendence of the Executive, we have to observe that some information of importance has lately been forwarded to us through the agent M. Chase. - Considering the situation in which the States Claim to the Stock now stands, we omit detailing the particulars at present as the original Communications filed in the Council Chamber will of course be resorted to in such manner as the General Assembly may think proper.
