That amount deducted from the said aggregate, shews this sum (which was the balance in the Western Shore Treasury 1st December, 1830,) to have been the unexpended balance of the entire income of the State from both Shores, for the year then ended. - - - - -	-	54,106 88
This sum however, was subject to appropriations to that day, then uncalled for— amounting to, - - - - -	-	24,268 24
And the clear, unappropriated balance in the Treasury 1st December, 1830, was	-	29,838 64
