At a meeting of the Trustees of the University of Maryland, held October 11th, 1830, at the office of the Secretary—

Amongst other, were the following proceedings:

Resolved, That the Executive Committee be and they are hereby authorised and required, to pay the debt due by certain Professors in the Faculty of Physic to the Bank of Baltimore, on account of a loan for building the Infirmary, out of the funds of the University, which are invested in United States Bank stock, on the following previous conditions:

- 1. That all the Professors in the said Faculty at present residing in the City of Baltimore, and who were such Professors in 1826, execute to the Trustees of the University all their right, title and interest, both at law and equity, in and to the University buildings and lot, and the Infirmary and lot.
- 2. That the Bank of Baltimore assign to the Trustees the judgment obtained by them against Granville S. Pattison, late a Professor in said Faculty.
- 3. That all the said Professors who are now residing in the City of Baltimore, execute a release, under seal, of all claims and demands both at law and in equity, which they have, or are supposed to have, upon the Trustees of the said University, and upon the State of Maryland.
