The select committee appointed under an order adopted by the House of Delegates, on the 25th ult., to inquire into the financial affairs of the Penitentiary of Maryland, Report as follows:

With a view of procuring the best information to be had on that subject, the committee caused to be summoned many witnesses who were believed to be the most familiar with the business and concerns of the Penitentiary, comprising persons who had been officially connected with the Institution, under the late and former administration of it.
