

LIST OF RESOLUTIONS

MADE AND PASSED

AT

DECEMBER SESSION, 1838.

No. 1 A resolution, directing the Librarian to furnish the clerk of Somerset county, with a copy of the laws of 1812.

2. A resolution, directing the Librarian to furnish to the clerks of the several county courts and register of wills, each, one copy of Dorsey's testamentary law.

3. A resolution, directing the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to pay to the members of the present General Assembly and its officers, the several and respective sums that may be due them and that may become due from time to time.

4. A resolution, directing the Librarian to furnish the clerk, register of wills for Prince George's county, a copy of the acts of Assembly for eighteen hundred and twenty.

5. A resolution, directing the Librarian to furnish the clerk of Worcester county court a copy of the acts of Assembly for 1820.

6. A resolution, directing the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to pay to Joseph F. Shaw, for the use of Teresa Hays the balance due to John H. Hays, a soldier of the revolution.

7. A resolution, directing the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to pay to Amelia Lord, (widow of Henry Lord) the sum of \$12 44 for three months and twenty two days services, of said Henry Lord in the revolutionary war, which was due at the time of his death.

8. A resolution, authorizing the Sheriff of Worcester county to release Parker Eshum, from confinement in Jail in said county.

9. A resolution, authorising the Treasurer of the Western Shore to pay to Leven Ballard, or order, \$9 66 due to Thomas Muer of Somerset county, at the time of his death.

10. A resolution, relating to the improvement of the harbour of Havre De Grace.

11. A resolution, directing the Librarian to furnish the Register of Wills and clerk of Frederick county, with the indexes to the laws of Maryland from 1818 to the present time.

12. A resolution in favor of Alice Markland, widow of Edward Markland, a revolutionary officer.

13. A resolution, authorising the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to pay to John B. Boyle as per order of Mary Magdaline
