

R E P O R T .

The Committee on Internal Improvement to which was referred the order submitted by Mr. Ridgely on the 10th of January, have in pursuance of said order, collected the testimony taken by the Committee on Internal Improvement at December session 1838, under the resolutions offered by Mr. Calvert on 7th of January, 1839, and having carefully examined, arranged and classified the same, respectfully report it to the house, and recommend that a selection thereof be printed. The committee report the entire testimony, so far as it could be obtained, to the house, arranged as follows, viz:

1. Testimony relating to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, from the Committee on Internal Improvement of December session 1838.

2. Thirteen important papers relating to the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company.

3. Three important papers relating to the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company: all of which they are of opinion should be printed; and ten papers which your committee deem unimportant. All of which is respectfully submitted.
