Sir: The undersigned respectfully report for the information of the Executive, that during the fiscal year ending on 30th inst.. seven consolidated lotteries were drawn for the benefit of the private grants, realizing the sum of fifteen hundred and sixty nine dollars and thirty eight cents, which has been paid over to Messrs. D. S. Gregory & Co. assignees of the grantees, and that there remains to be raised to satisfy the old private grants the sum of twelve thousand nine hundred dollars and forty three cents, beside twenty thousand dollars to aid in the establishment of a Female Seminary in Frederick city, and thirty thousand dollars to establish a Female Seminary in Saint Mary's county on the site of the ancient city of Saint
