RESOLUTIONS.

No. 1.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be, and he is hereby authorised and required, to deliver to the Secretary of State, to be transmitted to the several States and Territories, and to the Library of Congress, such surplus works now remaining in the Licrary, as the joint committee on the Library may direct.

No. 2.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be, and he is authorised and directed, to transmit one copy of Dorsey's Laws of Maryland, to the following public officers: The several Orphan's Courts—the several County Courts—the Judges of the Baltimore City Court and Office—the Attorney General—the Treasurers of the Eastern and Western Shore—the Land offices of the Eastern and Western Shore—the office of the Adjutant General—the City Council of Baltimore—the City Council of Annapolis—the office of Insolvent Commissioners—the Colleges in the State, Howard District—the Library of Congress—to each Department of the General Government—the Chancellor and Chancery office, and the Court of Appeals for the Eastern and Western Shore.

No. 3.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Librarian transmit to the Honorable John Leeds Kerr, forty-four copies of Bozman's History of Maryland, in acknowledgement of that gentleman's munificence in presenting to the State, that History in manuscript.

No. 4.

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be, and he is hereby authorised and required, to purchase a carpet for the Library room, and to cause the furnace to be repaired, provided the entire cost shall not exceed three hundred dollars, and the Treasurer of the Western Shore is hereby authorised to pay the same out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury.
