styled the Municipal Court of Baltimore; which said court when duly organised, shall have, hold and exercise, all and singular, the powers and jurisdiction now held and exercised by Baltimore City Court; and either of said judges shall be authorised to hold said court, and to hear and decide all cases pending therein; provided, that in cases where there may be a difference of opinion between said judges, the decision of the Chief Judge shall be taken as that of the court.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the salaries to be allowed to the Chief Judges and Associates of the several judicial districts, and to the Chief Judge of the Municipal Court of Baltimore, shall be fixed by the Legislature, at the session when this act may be confirmed, and the salaries so established shall not be diminished

during their continuance in office.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted. That all and every part of the constitution and form of government of this State, in any manner repugnant to or inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed, abrogated and annulled, upon the confirmation hereof; provided, that nothing herein contained shall be anstrued so as to authorise the removal of the clerks of the respective County Courts, or of the Court of Appeals, being in commission at the time of the confirmation of this act, in any other mode or manner than that prescribed by the constitution and form of government.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That if this act shall be confirmed by the General Assembly, after the next election of delegates, at the first session after such new election, as the constitution and form of government directs, that in such case this act, and the alterations and amendments of the constitution and form of government therein contained, shall be taken and considered, and shall constitute and be valid, as a part of said constitution and form of government, any thirty in said constitution and form of government to the con-

trary notwithstanding.
