that from the commencement of my term as Clerk of said Court, to the 1st of January 1850, I had usually employed thirteen Clerks in said office; during a part of the year 1850, there were fifteen, and for the residue of that year seventeen such Clerks so employed—which was the largest number in the office at any one time, during my term, except for a month or two immediately preceding its close; when I deemed it proper to employ two additional Clerks, to expedite the winding up of the office business.
