## TREASURY DEPARTMENT.

Comptroller's Office, Annapolis, Md., 12th Feb. 1853.

To the Hon. ELIAS WARE, Jr., Speaker.

Sir:—In obedience to the order of the House of Delegates, of yesterday, requesting me to report a detailed statement of the returns made to the Treasury by William H. Gatchell, late Clerk of Baltimore city Court, due on the first Monday in June and the first Monday in November 1851, his several payments within the fiscal year, ended the first of December 1851, and on what account made; and also, a statement of the revenue which accrued in his hands from the first Monday of November 1851 to the 26th day of said month, being the day on which he retired from office; I have the honor to submit the accompanying statement.

The difference between the amount of the revenue which accrued in the year and the amount of his payments on account of the revenue accrued in the year, consists in his commissions of \$2,385.61 thereon, and in the semi-annual tax of \$525 on his office due the first November 1851, but not paid until within the fiscal year 1852.
