Resolved, That it is the duty of this Committee to carry out fully the instructions and commands laid upon them by the resolutions of the House of Delegates, and to report fully upon the facts found upon a thorough examination of witnesses on oath; and also such remedy for the existing evils, if any should be found to exist, as in their judgment the nature of such evils may require. and nays being required, appeared as follows:
