 and light a candle and as the said John Gibb was holding the Wax  
 to the candle his hand shook and the said James Mafsey Sen. asked  
 the said John Gibb whether he should melt the Wax to which the said  
 John Gibb replied no Neighbour Mafsey you shall not I will do it  
 my self that they may all see I do it fairly that there may be no  
 dispute hereafter and that after the said Will was executed the said  
 James Mafsey Sen. spoke to Janet Celand and desired her not to  
 say any thing more to her Uncle to anger him seeing it was not  
 his pleasure to leave her any thing to which the said Janet  
 Celand answered she had done with it, she had done with it  
 before God and Man
