

All Inhabitants of this province shall take an Oath of Allegiance to his Majestie.

The Lord Proprietor shall have all his rights and prerogatives.

The Inhabitants of this Province shall have all their rights and liberties according to the great Charter of England.

The Lieutenant Generall within the province and the commander of the Isle of Kent (within that Island) except appeal be made from him & the counsell of the province in causes wherein the Lieutenant Generall is a plaintiff shall cause right and Justice to be done in all causes civil (wherein right or damage is demanded) according to the laws or laudable usages of this Province or otherwise according to the laws or laudable usages of England in the same or the like cases as near as he or they shall be able to Judge and Shall trie all the said causes and shall or may use command & appoint all power & means necessary or conduced therunto. And the said Lieutenant Generall & commander shall take an oath to administer equal Justice to all persons without favour or malice of any one.

The Lieutenant Generall or anyone of the Counsell (within the province) and the commander of the Isle of Kent (within that Island) shall or may use command & appoint all power & means necessary or conduced to the apprehending of felons or the keeping of the peace and the Lieutenant Generall and counsell shall or may trie and sentence all offenders with any punishment as they shall think the offence to deserve except that in crimes extending to taking away of life or member the offender shall be first indicted and afterward tried by twelve freemen at the least and the commander
