hundred and fifty intituled an Act concerning
the Seavoying of warr within this Province in the
last of which ~~which~~ act the whole charge
of any warr arising within this Province is to
be levied upon the Province by an equal
assessment upon the persons and Estates of the
Inhabitants thereof any thing in that act or
any other act to the contrary thereof notwith-
standing And further taking into serious con-
sideration the burden of that act and the vast
charge that hath been drawn upon the Province
by the late treacherous Revolt of Josias Fendall
and his complices and the great expence they
must be at to defend the Province against the
Incursions of the Saneado Indians that of
late have murdered some of the Inhabitants
thereof the which charge by act of this present
Assembly they have undertaken Doe pray that
by authority of the Lord Proprietary with the
assent of the upper and lower house of this Genl^l
Assembly the said act made at an Assembly held
the second day of January one thousand six
hundred forty six at St Inagoes forte And intituled
An Act for customes may be repealed And be
it enacted by the authority and consent aforesaid
that the said Act for customes is hereby utterly
Repealed for ever

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
