An Act concerning Indians

Whereas sundry complaints have been made by
severall Inhabitants alleadging that the Indians
under pretence of killing wild Hogs doe hunt
and drive away their tame hogs and fettle and
doe moreover sell and trade both with the In-
habitants of the province and likewise with
Foreigners or Strangers for beef and pork for
prevention of which for the future Be it Enac-
ted by the Lord Proprietary by and with the
assent of this Generall Assembly that att and
every inhabitant of this Province Stranger or
Foreigner upon what pretence so ever trading
or buying of any Indian or Indians more or less
quantity of dead beef or pork shall forfeit for every
such offence five thousand pounds of Tobacco
the one Moyety to the Lord Proprietary the other
moyety to the informer to be recovered by action
of debts or information wherein no wager
of lawne or protection of Law to be allowed this
Act to endure for three years or to the end of the
next Generall Assembly

An Act For the purchasing of a State
