as amounts to the debt recovered and costs of suite  
menconed in the witt of Execution provided also  
that no Sheriff of an County within this Province  
Shall by any attachment or Execution had upon  
such attachment or any other Execution what  
ever obtained in any Court within this Province  
Leavy and seize or take the goods and chattells of  
any Inhabitant within this Province that  
Shall be then Present or absent as aforesaid so  
far as to deprive them of all livelihood for the future  
but that none for necessary maintenance Beding  
gunnare pott and necessary Labours tools  
with such like household implements and an  
union for subsistence shall be protected from  
all such attachments and Executions so long as he  
or they shall Inhabit within this Province And  
provided also that such as Shall be found by proof  
of other Circumstance willfully to absent themselves  
into the woods or else where from the Sheriffs sight  
whereby they cannot be found to be brought to a tryall  
and such also as shall be intended to depart or fly  
out of the Province (to be sworne upon oath) Shall  
have no benefit of this Law but that an attachment  
or Execution may issue forth on all or any of his or  
their goods or chattells This act to endure for three  
Years or to the end of the next General Assembly  
which shall first happen

### An Act For Recording the Journall of the Lower house
