

every person or persons who shall hereafter at any time make any
attempt or attempts, or any entry or entries off or for any money,
goods, chattels, commodities or merchandizes whatsoever, to or for
the use of y^e L^d Prop^{ty} or his heirs, unto or with his or their Secretary
of this Province for the time being, or unto any other officer or
minister of y^e L^d Prop^{ty} & his heirs, by him or them from time
to time appointed, or to be appointed to receive or take such attempt
or to make such entry, & shall not make or deliver a true and
just account or entry off or for any such money, goods, chattels,
commodities or merchandizes as aforesd, but shall conceal y^e same
such person or persons, after proof thereof made, shall forfeit to
y^e L^d Prop^{ty} & his heirs, all such monys, goods, chattels,
commodities or merchandizes soe concealed, & wheroff true & just
accout or entry shall not be made. And,

Be it further enacted by y^e authority aforesd That all and
every person or persons within this Province, who have been, shall or may
be intrusted w^t any money, goods, chattels or merchandizes to or for
y^e use of y^e L^d Prop^{ty} or his heirs, shall take his corporall oath upon
y^e holy Evangelists, to be administered by y^e Secretary or other officer
thereunto appointed by y^e L^d Prop^{ty} or his heirs, who shall have
power from time to time, by virtue of this Act, to administer y^e same,
if they think fitt, that all attempt or entries for any such money,
goods, chattels or other merchandizes as aforesd, are true & just.

An act concerning trade with the Indians.

Be it enacted by y^e L^d Prop^{ty}, w^t y^e consent of y^e upper
& lower house of this Assembly, that from henceforward every
Inhabitant of this Province shall haue free liberty to trade with
any Indian or Indians within this Province for any Beabes or other
commodities, & to passe upon any River or Creek, or other passage
through any part of this Province to trade for y^e like commodities
w^t any Indian or Indians without this Province, & to export the
commodities or any of them so to be traded for from time to time, out
of this Province, Excepting Corn, w^t shall not be exported out of
this Province w^t speciall leave for y^e same to be obtained from
time to time from y^e Lieut or chiefe Governo^r of y^e Province, or such
other officer or officers for y^e time being, as he or y^e L^d Prop^{ty}
or his heirs Lords & Prop^{ts} of this Province shall from time to time
appoint, paying a tenth in weight or value for all y^e Beabes soe
traded for, for a custome to his L^d ship & his heirs Lords and
Prop^{ts} of this Province. Provided that no person or persons, who
