

bee enlisted into the militia or draining bands as aforesaid, and
 being so enlisted shall not from time to time as hee shall bee sum-
 moned or warned as aforesaid appeare & bring with him, one
 good serviceable fixed gunn & six shott of powder shall for
 every such offence, if a freeman forfeite & pay the sume of one
 hundred pounds of Tobacco to the Lord Prop: or if a serv. settled or
 hired by his master, mistresse or overseer then such master
 mistresse or overseer to forfeite & pay the like sume of one hun-
 dred pounds of Tobacco for every such serv. for the use of the foot
 company, to purchase drumme & Colours & other necessarys for
 the company, as the Commander shall thinke fitt, where such
 default is made, **provided** that this clause bee not to counte-
 nance any officer or officers to presse drumb or amunition for
 any further expedition or service then draining, but that upon
 all such occasions they bee supplied out of the County Magazine or
 store, all which forfeiture & forfeitures shall by such Justice Major
 or Cap: bee certified to the Commission: of the County Court for such
 County at the Court then next ensuing, who are hereby authori-
 zed upon such certificate (not sufficient excuse appearing to them
 to the contrary) ag: the goods & chattels of such person for refuse-
 ing, neglecting, or failing as aforesaid & that upon occasion of all
 such Expenditures all & every County Clerk & Sheriffe within this
 Province Respectively, shall doe what pertaineth to their offices
 without any fee or reward.

And for the setting of the horse forces that each Cap: of horse
 in each respective County shall for the making upp his troop elect
 & enlist his number of men out of the inhabitants of the said County
 according to such instructions as hee shall from time to time receive
 from the Lord Prop: his heirs & Successors, or his or theirs & for the
 time being, provided always that such Troopers shall ride their own
 horses, & no person shall bee a Trooper without hee bee owner of a
 good serviceable horse which shall passe muster, and that such
 Troopers in consideration of their great pay hereafter to bee allowed
 bee bound & obligated to find themselves with good & sufficient
 furniture for their horses & likewise to find themselves with sword
 & bined Pistolls holsters & amunition, and if any Trooper shall neglect
 & refuse upon notice given to them in manner as aforesaid to the foot
 to appeare att musters att the time & place aforesaid, appointed by
 each respective County of horse mounted & equipped as aforesaid
 shall forfeite & pay the sume of one hundred pounds of Tobacco, to the
 Lord Prop: to bee levied in manner as aforesaid for the use of the
 Troop for drumme & Colours & other necessarys as the Commander
 shall thinke fitt, And that such Troopers for & in consideration aforesaid
