Charles absolute Lord & Prop^{ty} of the Province

advise & Consent of the freemen of our Province & of their
delegates in a certaine Assembly held at St. Marys the 26th
Day of Octob^r last past, wee have ordained and enacted
severall Lawes (vizt)

An Act for Reviving & Tempora- rizing Lawes of this Province.

Be it enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^{ty}
by & with the Advise & Consent of the upper & lower houses of
this present Gen^l Assembly & the Authority of the same that one
Act made at a Gen^l Assembly held at St. Johns the 17th Day
of April 1669: Entituled an Act for Appointm^t of certaine officers
excepting the latter Clause thereof relating to sherriffes which is
not Revived, one other Act made the same Assembly entituled an
Act Concerning the Heith of ffences, one other Act made at the same
Assembly entituled an Act for Conveyance of Letters Concerning
the State & Publi^c affaires, one Act made at a Gen^l Assembly
held at St. Marys the first Day of April 1662: Entituled an Act
Concerning Indians, one Act made at a Gen^l Assembly held at
St. Marys the 11th Day of Septemb^r 1663: the^re Continued untill
the 3rd Day of Octob^r following, & from thence Adjourned untill the
2nd Tuesday in Septemb^r 1664: Entituled an Act prohibiting arrests
upon Sabbath Daye & Daye of Gen^l Muster & Draining, one other
Act made the same Assembly, Entituled an Act for Alterrem^t in
the Prov^l & County Courts, one Act made the same Assembly
Entituled an Act Concerning Proceedings at Law, Except one Clause
in the latter end thereof, (vizt) soe farre as the Court shall Judge
them not Inconsistent with the Condition of this Province, which is
not to bee Revived, one other Act made the same Assembly, Entituled
an Act ag^t the Exportation of Woolle & old Iron, one Act made at a
Gen^l Assembly held at St. Marys the 10th Day of April 1666: &
Entituled an Act Prohibiting Trade with Indians for any flesh
Dead or alive, Except Deer & wildfowle, one other Act made the
same Assembly, Entituled an Act Prohibiting fforeign Ingresses,
