

to be Exported out of y<sup>e</sup> Kingdom of England & payable in y<sup>e</sup> said Kingdom shall (Except base Coynt) be paid taken & recd. with the demands of the same sterling in y<sup>e</sup> value of twelve pence sterling in every p<sup>er</sup> cent proportionable **And it is by y<sup>e</sup> Authority aforesaid hereby further Enacted** y<sup>e</sup> all such money & Coynt so advanced as aforesaid shall be received & taken for value aforesaid in all paym<sup>ts</sup> to be contracted for & paid in ready money under y<sup>e</sup> paine y<sup>e</sup> upon sufficient proofe made of such y<sup>e</sup>son or y<sup>e</sup>sons so refusing to Export therof for or in satisfaction of any debt due by Bill Contract dro<sup>tt</sup> or otherwise at such rates & advance as aforesaid shall loose his or their debts & debts soe due as aforesaid never to be recovered of y<sup>e</sup> Debtor in any Court of Record or by any other means whatsoever Law by Statute or Custom ~~whatsoever~~ to y<sup>e</sup> contrary notwithstanding **And be it further Enacted** by y<sup>e</sup> Authority aforesaid y<sup>e</sup> noe y<sup>e</sup>son or y<sup>e</sup>sons whatsoever ~~any~~ Inhabitant within this Province shall Export or attempt to Export out of this Province any of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Coynt or money soe advanced as aforesaid under y<sup>e</sup> paine of forfeiture of y<sup>e</sup> said money soe Exported or intended to be Exported as aforesaid one halfe or Moety therof to y<sup>e</sup> Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>er</sup> & other halfe to y<sup>e</sup> Informer or him or them y<sup>e</sup> shall sue for y<sup>e</sup> same in any Court of Record within this Province by bill plaint or Informacion wherin noe Effoynd protestion or wager of Law to be allowed provided y<sup>e</sup> nothing in this Act shall be taken or construed to alter y<sup>e</sup> Lawes already made & promises in reference to his Lo<sup>rd</sup>s but y<sup>e</sup> his Lo<sup>rd</sup>s shall have take & receive his Rents fines & Alienuations This Imposition of two shillings p<sup>er</sup> hogthead & all other duties to him payable in such manner & forme as y<sup>e</sup> same is already made & provided for to all intents & purposes as if this Act had never been made **And be it further Enacted** by y<sup>e</sup> Authority aforesaid y<sup>e</sup> all officers whatsoever having holding or enjoying any place of profit under y<sup>e</sup> Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>er</sup> in this Province to whom any fees or fees are or shall be legally due and payable for doing executing or performing any matter or thing belonging to their Respective Office and also every licensed Ordinary keepers within this Province shall not refuse but are & every of them are hereby Obligated to receive & take after y<sup>e</sup> rate of six shillings of say advanced Coynt as aforesaid in lieu instead of every hundred pound of Cobanoe as aforesaid due & payable y<sup>e</sup> is to say y<sup>e</sup> said Officers for their fees & y<sup>e</sup> said Ordinary keepers for their accommodations provided y<sup>e</sup> said soe advanced Coynt in Money be tendered
