Land shall extend and that such Sale to as at to be
made by the said Benjamin shall be as firm and valid
to all Intents and purposes as if the said Benjamin had
been in Express terms named and empowered in and by
the said Will to do the same.

**Act for Transferring and Setting
over unto Major William Whitt-**

ington the Debts due from the Officers of Somerset
County by virtue of an Act for raising a Supply to-
wards the defraying of the public Charge of this Pro-
vince

Whereas by Virtue of a certain Act of Assembly made
at an Assembly held at Annapolis the 8th day of May Anno
1695 Entituled an Act for raising a Supply Towards
the defraying of the public Charge of this Province there
are diverse Sums of Tobacco arisen and become due
this Province from the severall and respective Officers -
within the Limits and precincts of Somerset County and
or as much as the said Major William Whittington has
