 the same is due in money ~~Shall~~ at the rate of Ten Shillings ~~per~~
 who are hereby obliged to accept and receive the same in full
 discharge thereof to be drawn out of the ~~publick~~ Treasury of this
 Province in manner and forme following (that is to say) Major
 John Hammond, Cap^t Richard Hill, M^r Samuel Young, M^r John
 Worthington or any three of them whereof the said Major Hammond
 to be one be and are hereby authorized and Impowered to draw
 the severall Notes for so much particularly as shall be due to the
 severall persons in the said Journalls named for payment of the
 aforesaid publick Charge upon the severall Treasurers of this
 Province **Provided** always that such Summes are due to
 severall Gentlemen residing on the Eastern Shore shall be ~~pay~~
 allotted and paid out of the Stock remaining in the Treasurers
 hands on that Shore so far as the same will extend, to ^{the} ~~the~~
 & Tickers the said severall Treasurers are hereby obliged
 and pay which said Notes or Tickers & receipts enclosed
 shall be sufficient to discharge such Treasurer or Treasurers
 for the same.
