

411 discharge his Lordship from accounting for the Arrears of the Due Scutting & Logwood for supporting the Government and providing Arms and Ammunition but that he be obliged to all the aforesaid matters & things as fully and strongly as if the said Law were in full force —

412 & it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid

that every Master of a Ship or Vessel as aforesaid at the time of his Roaring shall upon Oath declare the Quality and Quantity of his Loadings and that the Naval Officer by the Governor aforesaid appointed for that Roaring shall and is hereby empowered to administer the said Oath and if the said Master shall refuse the said Oath or upon Suspition of having Goods on board for which he hath not roared it shall and may be lawfull for the said Naval Officer to enter on board any such Ship or Vessel and the same to search for any such Goods as aforesaid any thing in this Act notwithstanding
