whereas that noe breach of peace may happen betwix the nearey bordering Indians and the Inhabitants of this Province & that Enacted by the Lord Proprietary to the advise and
consent of the Inhabitants of this Province that noe Indian or Indians what so ever or endeavour or attempt
shall be enterprized to prize or transport or cause to bee transported out of this Province and sell or dispose of any Indian or Indians what so ever or endeavour or attempt
thereunto shall suffer death but not forfet their or any of their estates howbeit any one in forning or causing such offender or offenders to bee apprehended
offenders estate and goods to the Governor and Council shall thencefull And it is further enacted by the authority aforesaid that noe inhabitant of this Province shall
to any Indian borne of Indian parents for the killing of any man or to any other without speciall licence from the Governor for the time being upon payment
of a sume and losse of the said sume to sign that hee mighte firsche thereon or take the same from such Indian or Indians informe & make proofe thereto of Andrew Duzamazing

AN ACT for taking an oath of fidelity to the road Proprietary.

and practised by the Lord Proprietor with the advice and consent of the upper and lower house of this Assembly, that every person from time to time inhabiting
the same or being at all and time in person in the same shall take the Hatchet and do mention'd the Hatch of fidelity to the Lord Proprietor
the holy Evangelist by the Lieutenant or Lieut' Governor of his Province for the time being or by such person or persons as he or the Lord Proprietor of this
Province appoints and authorise for the administration thereof as aforesaid And if any person or persons whatsoever be hereafter called into this Province
Evangelist according to the true intent and meaning of this Act when it shall be so administered unto him or them respectively as aforesaid and they respec-
tively shall refuse to administer the same from the Lord Proprietor or his heirs & executors and Proprietaries of this Province or his or their
successors in the said office and not return again unto it without leave from the Lord Proprietor or his heirs & executors and Proprietaries of this Province or his or their
successors in the said office or shall after such return again to the said hatch upon the said holy Evangelist according to the true intent
and meaning of this Act shall be deemed to have been a negatire voice against the said hatch and the other offices intended

All Act concerning & Accountants to the Lord Proprietary

Act concerning Accouments to the Lord Proprietary
Be it enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Province by and with the advice and approbation of the upper and lower house of this Assembly that all and every person or persons
or attorneyes or for any money goods chattells commodities or marchandizes what so ever to or for the use of the Lord Proprietary or his heirs unto or to his or their Secret
of the Lord Proprietary and his heires by hym or them from tyme to tyme appointed or to bee appointed to receive or take such Accoumt or to make such entry And
money goods chattells commodities or marchandizes as aforesaid but shall conceal the same by reason or persons after yor off the same made shall forfeit to the Lord Proprietary
Marchandizes concealed and who doth use and just account or entry shall not bee made and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that all and every
to any money goods chattells or marchandizes to or for the use of the said Lord Proprietary or his heirs shall take his or her oyle hath upon the halfe danger
to the Lord Proprietary or his heirs who shall have power from tyme to tyme by virtue of this Act to administer the same if they think fit that all such Accou-
