last recited Act stand in full force and Virtue and be inseparably annexed
to the said last recited Act. Provided also that from and after the end of
that present Session of Generall Assembly in Case of Shipwreck or taking
of any Ship or Vessell Ship or Vessell so that the Tobacco therein
Laden should be Lost before the delivery of the Ship or Vessell at his or
their port, then the Master Merchant or other Owner of such Tobacco
so Laden and Lost as aforesaid should be repayed the said Duty or Imposition
of Two Shillings ff. ff. or have Liberty to Ship at some other time so
many Hogsheads of Tobacco as they had paid money for as aforesaid free
and Clear of any the said Impositions as by the said severall Acts -
Relation being thereunto had it may more fully and at large appear.
Your Lordships most humble Loyall and obedient Servants
the Citizens and Delegates of this your Lordships lower House of
Assembly taking into their serious Consideration the many signall
Favours and Benignity by your Lordship Conferred on this House
for the common Utility of the good people of this Province and for a
gratefull acknowledgment of your Lordships paternall Respects to
your Lordships good people, and in demonstration of their Loyalty
and Love they Bear to your Lordship, and also to your Lordships beloved
Issue the Honble Charles Calvert Esq. your Lordships Son and Heir
do humbly pray that it may be Enacted. &c. And.

Be it Enacted by the right Honble the Lord Proprietor
and with the advice and consent of the upper and lower Houses of
Assembly that the said last recited Act, and all and every the Articles
Provisions, Matters and things therein Contained be and shall stand
and be by this present Act Ratified and Confirmed to all intents
and purposes according to the true intent and meaning thereof not
only during the Life of your Lordship our Lord and Proprietor of this
Province, but also for and during the naturall Life of the Honourable
Cecilius Calvert Esq. your Lordships Son and Heir, and no longer.
And in Case the said Cecilius Calvert Esq. shall Happen to Survive
your Lordship then from and after your Lordships Decease the said Duty
and Imposition of Two Shillings ff. ff. shall be Levied, Raised
Collected and paid to the said Cecilius Calvert Esq. for and during
the term of his naturall Life as aforesaid in such manner and under such
penalties and forfeitures as by the said recited Act is limited and
appointed to be paid to your Lordship as aforesaid. Provided always Never-
theless that all and every the severall Provisions in the said severall
Acts Contained do and shall during the Continuance of this Act
stand in full force and Virtue, and be inseparably annexed hereunto.
