very charged of necessary Clothing and Tools for themselves and families
are become vastly indebted and now prospect do yet appearing of any means
whereby they may extricate themselves out of their miserable and deplorable
and distressed which are yet very much heightened and aggravated by their being
brought and brought to Annapolis from the remotest parts of this province to
