 hundred and fourtoe and to Continue sitting at the City of Annapolis
 adjournment from the end of this present Session of Assembly until they
 shall fully finish and bring with what is required of them by law let and
 to order the payment thereof to the several persons to whom it is allowed
 in the same Journals of accounts according to the severall and respective
 allowances to them therein made and also to ord^r the said sum of three
 hundred forty four pounds and nine pence in money out of the publick Stock
 of this province in Treasurers hands to the severall persons to whom the same
 is allowed in the said Journals according to their severall and respective
 allowances to them therein made as aforesaid and also that the said
 Committee was aforesaid appointed to laye and order such further sumes of
 mony and Tobacco as shall be sufficient to defray the necessary Charge
 of the said Committee according to their Usual & Lawfull Allowances &
 no more to be Raised Levy & Ordered and paid as aforesaid and
 the sume of tobacco that shall be so apportioned for pay by the said
 Committee shall be levied by way of Execution upon the bodye goods or chattels
 of every taxable person within this province by the severall Sheriffs
 of the respective Countys in such manner as by other Laws of this
 province is directed and provided and that writs of Execution be to that
 end accordingly issued by any officer Majesties Justices of the Prov
 Court under their hand and Seal or under their hand and the Seal of y^e same
 Court to be directed to the severall Sheriffs according to and that the
 said Committee transmitt a true Journaile of all their proceedings to the
 Assembly within convenient time to be Lodged in the Assembly office
 for the safefaction of all persons therewill concerned
