And the following Private Laws:

An ACT to cut off the Entail of a Parcel of Land called Roper's Neck, and to enable Benjamin Howard to convey the same in Fee in Exchange for other Lands.

An ACT for the cutting off the Entail and investing an Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple in part of a Tract of Land called Coopers Purchaje in Thomas Spalding and Catharine his Wise, and to Entail other Lands lying in St. Mary's County in lieu thereof.

An ACT investing Archibald Douglas of Cacil County Son and Heir of William and Mary Douglas, Deceased, with an Estate in Fee Simple in the one Mosty of a Track of Land called the Level or Scutt's Level, Joing in Baltimore County.

CT to cut off and har the Entail of part of a certain Tract of called Williams's Range in Prince George's County, and to Lands in lieu thereof.
