Preamble.

HEREAS the Rector, Vestrymen, and Churchwardens of Tri-. nity Parish in Charles County, have by their Petition to this General Assembly set forth, that the Justices of Charles County aforesaid did not, for want of Application, levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Trinity Parish asoresaid, in November Court, One thousand seven hundred and filty one, one third Part of the Tobacco which, by the above recite, Act, they were impowered to do, amounting to the Quantity of Eighteria

thousand three hundred thirty and three Pounds of Tobacco.

18333 lb. of Tobacco to be levied on the faid Parish, in 1754.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's President, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of Charles County, upon the Application of the Rector, Vestrymen, and Churchwardens of Trinity Parish in Charles County aforesaid, to them to be made, at November Court, which shall be held for the County asoresaid in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred fifty and sour, it shall and may be lawful for the said Justices, and they are hereby impowered and directed to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Trinity Parish aforefaid, the said Sum of Eighteen thousand three hundred thirty and three Pounds of Tobacco, together with the Sheriff's Salary of five Pounds of Tobacco per Centum for collecting the same, to be applied and laid out as the aforesaid Act entituled, An Act to enable the Justices of Charles County to assess and levy on the taxable Inhabitants of that Part of the late Rev. Mr. Donaldson's Parish, which lies in the said County, Fifty-five Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, and for other Purposes therein mentioned, directs, and not otherwife.

A Supplementary Act to the Act entituled, "An

" Act for the Appointment of Constables and what

" relates to their Office; and ascertaining what Per-

" fons are Taxables."

Preamble.

HEREAS, by the above-recited Act, it is amongst other Things Enacted, " That the Justices of Peace in every respective Coun-"ty of this Province, at the first County Court held after Mi-" chaelmas, shall appoint Constables in each Hundred of their several and " respective Counties; and the said Constables so appointed shall before they " enter into that Office, take the several Oaths appointed to be taken by all " Officers, by the Acts of Assembly of this Province, and the Oath of a " Constable."
