Acts of Assembly passed in October, 1753.

Prison, by a former Act of Assembly is directed to be built, would (in Case the fame should take Fire) not only greatly endanger the Court-House, but also the Records of the laid County, and have therefore prayed that an Ad may pals, impowering the Justices of Prince-George's County, to levy a Sum not exceeding Three Thouland Pounds of Tobacco, to be applied in the Purchale of a Lot of Ground in Upper-Mariberough Town, as may feem most convenient and safe, whereon to build the said County Prison:

II. BE it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprie- 3000 lbs. of Tobacco, to tary, by and with the Advice and Conjent of his Lordfisp's Governor, and be kvied in the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, Pr. George's That the Justices of Prince-George's County, for the Time being, shall, and County; they are hereby authorized and directed, at their Court, to be held in November Seventeen Hundred and Fifty Three, to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Prince-George's County, a Sum not exceeding Three Thouland Pounds of Tobacco, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five per Cent, for Collection thereof, which Sum, to affessed and levied, shall be collected by the Sheriff of Prince-George's County, who is hereby required to pay the same to the Justices of the said County for the Time being, or their Order

or Orders.

III. AND be it further Enasted, That the said Justices are hereby To purchase authorized and required, out of the Sum not exceeding Three Thouland a Lot where-Pounds of Tobacco aforesaid, to contract with and Purchase of any Person of Prison. Persons whatsoever, a Lot of Land in any Part of the said Upper-Mariberough Town they shall think fit, thereon to build a new Prison for the laid County, instead of the Place appointed and directed by a former Act, and that the Conveyance or Conveyances for the same Lot of Land shall be, and are hereby directed and required to be by Deed, Indented, and to be made between the Vendor or Vendors of the First Part, and the said Justices for the Time being of the Second Part, and shall be deemed, construed and taken, to be the said Justices for the Time being, and to their Successors, to and for the proper Use and Behoof of the Inhabitants of the said County for ever.

IV. AND be it likewise Enasted, That any Person or Persons agreeing, contracting, or bargaining with the Justices of the said County, for the Building the laid Piison, on the Lot or Parcel of Land whereon the Court-House now stands, shall, and he or they are hereby declared to be, obliged to build the said Prison on such Lot or Parcel of Land as shall be bought, and appointed by the Justices aforesaid, for that Purpose, as if the said Agreement, Contract, or Bargain, had been made for the Building the Prison aforesaid, on the Lot of Land to be bought, and appointed for that Purpose,

in Virtue of this Act.

An Act to enable the Justices of Frederick County, for the Time being, to Levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, a Sum of Money, for the Uses therein mentioned.

HEREAS, by an Act of Assembly, made and passed at a Preamble.
