SEPTEMBER SESSION, 1770.

CHAP.

- A** N ACT continuing an Act, entitled, "An Act for amending the Staple of Tobacco, for preventing Frauds in his Majesty's Customs, and for the Limitation of Officers Fees, and the Supplementary Act thereto." I.
An ACT directing the Sale of the Lands of *Richard Heard*, late of *Saint Mary's County*, deceased, for the Payment of the Debts of the said *Richard Heard*. [A Private A^t.] II.
An ACT to enable the Justices of *Somerset County* to levy, on the taxable Inhabitants of *Somerset Parish* in the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco for the Purposes therein mentioned. III.
An ACT for abolishing *Jane County* Courts, and for other Purposes therein mentioned. IV.
An ACT for the Adjournment and Continuance of the High Court of Appeals, and for the Adjournment of the Provincial Court, and other Purposes therein mentioned. V.
An ACT to invest *John Clayton* with an exclusive Privilege and Benefit of making and selling a Machine for threshing of Wheat, on a Model by him invented. [A Private A^t.] VI.
An ACT to give *Thomas Harrison* further Time to effect the Removal of a Nuisance in *Baltimore Town* in *Baltimore County*. VII.
An ACT to empower the Justices of *Somerset* and *Worcester* Counties to levy, on the taxable Inhabitants of *Stepney Parish* in the said Counties, the Quantity of Eighty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, for the Uses therein mentioned. VIII.
An ACT for empowering the Justices of *Queen Anne's* and *Talbot* Counties, to assess the taxable Inhabitants of *Saint Paul's Parish* in the said Counties, the Sums of Tobacco, therein mentioned, for building a Church, and repairing the Chapel of the said Parish. IX.
An ACT to oblige the several County Clerks to have with them, on their Office Days, the Four last Courts Dockets and Papers. X.
An ACT to remedy a Defect in the Title of *Bartholomew Pomeroy* of *London*, Merchant, to a Tract or Parcel of Land called *Rencher's Adventure*, lying in *Prince George's County*. [A Private A^t.] XI.
An ACT to unite the Free-Schools of *Somerset* and *Worcester* Counties. XII.
An ACT to enable the Justices of *Dorchester County* Court, to assess and levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco, for the Purpose of building a Court-House. XIII.
An ACT to repeal Part of an Act, to encourage the destroying of Wolves, Crows and Squirrels. XIV.
An additional Supplementary ACT to the Act, entitled, "An Act for erecting a new Parish in Kent County, called *Chester Parish*, and for building a Parish Church, and enlarging a Chapel of Ease within the said Parish." XV.
An ACT for the building a Parish Church in *Queen Anne Parish* in *Prince George's County*. XVI.
An ACT to remedy a Defect in the Acknowledgment of a Conveyance from *Iosiah Conant* to *William Thornton*. [A Private A^t.] XVII.
An ACT to divide *Saint John's Parish* in *Baltimore County*. XVIII.
An ACT to invest *Isaac Perkins* with an exclusive Privilege of making and selling a Machine for threshing of Wheat, on a Model by him invented. [A Private A^t.] XIX.
An ACT for the Relief of *Thos W. Wootton*. XX.
An ACT directing the Sale of Part of the Lands of *Henry Baker*, late of *Cecil County*, deceased, for the Payment of the Debts of the said *Henry Baker*. [A Private A^t.] XXI.
An ACT for the Relief of *Nebemiah Tilghman* and *Solomon Townsend*, and to confirm the Contract made between the said *Nebemiah Tilghman* and a certain Major *Townsend*. [A Private A^t.] XXII.

- A** N ACT for the Adjournment and Continuance of *Baltimore County* Court. I.
An ACT empowering *Edward Tilghman*, *Solomon Wright*, and others, to sell certain Lands, devised by *Colonel Vincent Lowe*, formerly of *Talbot County*, to be sold for the Purposes by the said devise intended. [A Private A^t.] II.
A Supplementary ACT to the Act, entitled, "An Act to enable the Justices of *Queen Anne's* County Court, for the Time being, to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of *Saint Luke's Parish* in the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco for building a Chapel in the said Parish." III.
An ACT to establish a Market in *Frederick-Town* in *Frederick County*, and for the Regulation of the said Market. IV.
An ACT to remedy the Omission of the Enrolment of a Deed of Bargain and Sale, from *Thomas Collier* to *Terence Tilghman*, *William Lightfoot*, *Abraham Mitchell*, *Walter Franklin* and *Samuel Franklin*. [A Private A^t.] V.
An ACT for the Establishment of a Chapel of Ease in *Saint Peter's Parish* in *Talbot County*. VI.
A Supplementary ACT to the Act, entitled, "An Act for the Relief of the Poor within the several Counties, therein mentioned." VII.
An ACT for the Relief of certain Prisoners in the several Jails therein mentioned. VIII.
An ACT to divide *All-Saints Parish* in *Frederick County*, and to erect Two new Parishes, by the Names of *Eden Parish* and *Frederick Parish*. IX.
An ACT to enable *Nickolas Rogers*, an Infant, to dispose the real Estate therein mentioned. [A Private A^t.] X.
