And be it enasted, That if any Subject or Inhabitant of this And for cor-State, shall write or convey any Letter, or send or carry any Message, with Eneto any Person employed in the Service of Great-Britain, against the mies, &c. United States, or any of them, without the Leave of the Governor of this State, or some one of the General Officers of the Army of the United States, or shall knowingly receive or bring any Letter or Mcsfage from any fuch Person, and shall not deliver or communicate the same, as soon as conveniently may be, to the Governor, or some one of the Judges or Justices of the Peace within this State, and shall be thereof convicted in any County Court of this State, such Person shall be fined not exceeding one hundred Pounds current Money, in the Discretion of the Court.

X. And be it enacted, That if any Subject or Inhabitant of this Persons forg-State, shall within or without this State, and if any Person whatever Tickets, &c. shall within this State, forge or counterfeit any of the Tickets in the to suffer United States Lottery, or shall forge or counterfeit any of the Certificates, Bills, or Notes of the Continental Loan-Office, or alter the Sum expressed in any of the said Certificates, Bills or Notes, or shall offer, or cause to be offered, in Payment, any such counterfeit, forged, or altered Certificate, Bill or Note, knowing the same to be counterfeit, forged, or altered, and shall be thereof convicted in the General Court, or shall stand mute, or peremptorily challenge above the Number of twenty of the Pannel, such Person shall suffer Death as a Felon, without Benefit of Clergy.

XI.
