E it enaîted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That if any subject of this state shall, within or without this state, and if any person whatsoever shall, within this state, forge or counterfeit any certificate issued in virtue of the said act, entitled, An act for the payment of the journal of accounts, and for other purposes, or shall alter the sum expressed in any of the said certificates, or shall pass in payment any such counterfeit or altered certificate, knowing the same to be counterfeit or altered, and shall be thereof convicted in the general court of this state, or shall stand mute, or peremptorily challenge above the number of twenty of the pannel, such person shall suffer death as a selon, without benefit of clergy.
