of the aforesaid act, are entitled to, and shall receive, from the collector of his county, all sums of money which he hath paid as a penalty for not taking the said oath or affirmation, or have the same deducted out of his future assessment, paying to the collector his commission thereon.

CHAP.

VI. And, Whereas it is made appear to this general assembly, that Nathaniel Andrews, late of Dorchester county, had been prevented by sickness and inability, to take, repeat and subscribe the said oath or affirmation, agreeable to the directions of the aforesaid act for the better fecurity of the government;

VII. Be it therefore enacted, That the executor or administrator of Executor, &c. of Nathaniel the said Nathaniel Andrews, deceased, shall receive from the collector Andrews to of Dorchester county aforesaid, all sums of money which have at any receive the money he paid time heretofore been paid by the said Nathaniel Andrews in his life- as a penalty, time, or by his executor or administrator since the death of the said &c. Nathaniel, as a penalty for his, the said Nathaniel, in his life-time, not having taken the oath or affirmation aforesaid, agreeable to the directions of the act aforesaid for the better security of the government, the faid executor or administrator paying the said collector his commission on the collection aforesaid.
