An ACT to alter and change the name of Samuel Berry Atchion, Paffed Januaof Charles county.

HEREAS Samuel Berry Atchison, of Charles county, has petitioned Preamble. to this general affembly, that an act may pass to change his name to Samuel Atchifon Berry; and it appearing reasonable that the prayer of the petitioner should be granted, therefore,

H. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall and S. B. Atchimay be lawful for the said Samuel Berry Atchison to take upon himself the name fon to take the and surname of Samuel Atchison Berry, instead of his present name and sur- ry, &c. name, and also for the descendants of the said Samuel Berry Atchison to take upon themselves the surname of Berry; and the name of the said Samuel Berry Archifon shall be and is hereby changed and altered into the name of Samuel Atchifon Berry; and the said Samuel Berry Atchison, and the heirs of his body, fall at all times hereafter be called by, and hold and use, the surname of Berry only.

Ill. And be it enaded, That all securities, promises, contracts, assurances, Securities, teds and lawful acts whatfoever, heretofore made, or hereafter to be made, by effect, &c. to the taid Samuel Berry Atchison, by the name and surname of Samuel Arthifon Berry, shall be of the same force and effect, and equally avail, to all intents and purposes, as if the name and surname of Samuel Atchison Berry had then the true and proper name and surname of the said Samuel Berry Atchison from his birth, any law or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
