VHEREAS, special acts of legislation to authorise the removal of ves into this state have been numerous and of course greatly exsive to the state; And whereas, no great inconvenience can occur m a general law embracing most of such cases—Therefore, Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That if any zen of this state hath acquired or shall acquire property in any e or slaves being residents of any of the United States, by mare, bequest, course of distribution, or as guardian, or by gift, or in other lawful manner, such citizen may at any time remove and ng such slave or slaves for the purpose only of working or employsuch slave or slaves within this state, for his own immediate serand not for any other purpose: Provided, that a list of such slave Proviso. laves be rendered in the manner directed by the act of seventeen dred and ninety-six, chapter sixty-seven, and the act of eighteen dred and four, chapter ninety, and the act of eighteen hundred and
