Advice & Consent of our Council We have determined to call an Assembly of the Free-
men of our Province on the 17th day of April next ensuing there to consider of
certain Things concerning the State & Welfare of this our Province of Mary.
We Command you Nicholas Guyther Sherriſſ of St. Marys County that make
Proclamation as soon as conveniently may be after the receipt of this Writ
cause to be elected such & so many discreet men as you shall think fit to serve
as Burghesses in the said Assembly there to do & consent to such things as by com-
mon Consent shall happen to be ordained & enacted in the Business aforesaid.
That through want of sufficient power or inconsiderate Election of the Burghes-
ses, the Business aforesaid may not remain undone & neglected, and make if
Return of this Writ into the Secretarys Office by the Sixteenth of April next.
Given at St. Marys under our Great Seal of our said Province of Maryland
the Eight & twentieth day of February in the twenty ninth year of our Domi-
on over the said Province Annoq. Domini 1660
